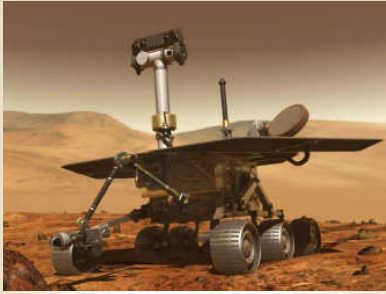

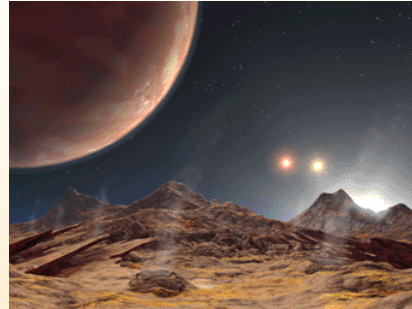
Conference Overview

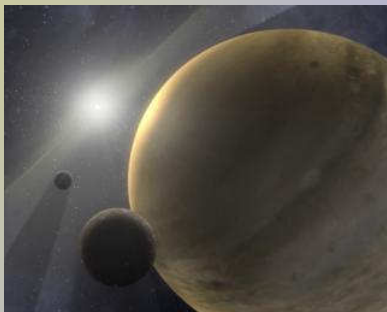

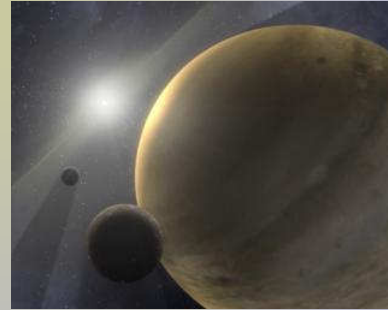
